

Town of Maxville
Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes
August 16, 2022

Dan Weisenbeck, Chairman, called the Regular Monthly Meeting of the Maxville Town Board of Supervisors to order at 6:00 PM, Tuesday 16th, 2022 at the Maxville Town Hall.

Roll Call/ Present: Chairman Dan Weisenbeck; Supervisor Bruce Kees; Supervisor Andy Hayden; Treasurer Carrie Lindstrom; Clerk Barb Traun and Jane Weisenbeck.

Minutes/Treasurer's Report: Minutes of the July 13th, 2022 meeting were read and approved as read. Treasurer's report showed that Maxville has a balance of \$139,677.93 including a cemetery fund total of \$7,078.43 & ARPA funds of \$15,829.51 leaving available funds of \$132,599.50 (includes 2nd ARPA payment \$15,804.95). Treasurer's report was approved as read.

Citizen's Concerns: No concerns. Dan had heard from Don Black and all present at the meeting had received compliments on the mowing of Maxville's town roads by the Pepin County Highway Department.

Correspondence/Announcements:

-Barb reported the voting machine's thermal printer did not work at Public Test. A loaner was received and used at the Aug. 9th Partisan Primary. No word yet as to the status of the town's machine.

-Barb asked Town Board to sign a 2nd notice letter/billing to Riverland Energy requesting reason for nonpayment. Board did so.

-Possible ARPA Ordinances were briefly discussed. WTA will keep all updated regarding their need.

-3rd Fire call billing will be sent to Mike Danzinger to determine if amount due will be a special charge on 2022 taxes payable 2023.

Town Hall Update: The aluminum cans are still at the recycling shed. After discussion, they will be put in the recyclable dumpster for the county pickup. Dan and Bruce will work on the eve troughs next couple of weeks when they are able.

-Schaul's Gas prepaid LP was discussed and approved. Bruce said Schaul's should be asked to clean the furnace this fall. Barb suggested returning to "keep fill" status.

-Dan will open WM/Recycling Center – Saturday August 20th.

Town Road Update:

-Pepin County Hwy Dept. is mowing town roads, again, they were doing a great job!

-Town of Canton's patrolman mowed/brushed Johnson Hill Road.

-Buffalo Co. Hwy Dept. grader patched Johnson Hill Rd; Castleberg Rd, Lindstrom Valley Rd and Price Rd. per request.

-Thibodeau Rd was chipped sealed also by Buffalo Co. Hwy Dept.
