RESOLUTION 12-13-2016
TOWN OF MAXVILLE CEMETERY AUTHORITY

All grave sites shall be held for burial places for the dead and for no other purposes.

A fee of \$150 per single grave site will be charged plus a \$150 charge for perpetual per single grave site. Total cost of a grave site being \$300 to be paid prior to burial.

Grave site holders purchase burial rights only in said grave site, not title to the land.

Gravesite holders shall have the right to erect any stone or monument such as has been approved and is in use in other cemeteries. Monuments and markers will have foundations and will not infringe on the neighboring grave site. The cemetery is not liable for maintenance of foundations and markers. The cemetery is not responsible for vandalism to the grave monument, nor are they covered under the Town's insurance. Individuals, if they desire, will have to obtain their own insurance if they desire this protection.

Grave enclosures, enclosures around burial lots, and trellises are prohibited.

The planting of trees and shrubs on lots or graves is prohibited.

Glass jars and pots to be used as flower containers are prohibited.

Anyone cleaning their gravesite must remove all rubbish. Burning in the cemetery is prohibited.

Loose decorations, artificial wreaths, etc. should be removed from all graves by October 1st of every year so the cemetery can be cleaned up before winter. If decorations are not removed the Town or its contracted mower has the right to dispose of them.

The Town or its contracted mower has the authority to clean the cemetery of all brush and tall flowers that are in the way of the mower.

The Town or its contracted mower is not responsible for flowers being broken or artificial flowers and decorations being removed from graves or destroyed.

Many markers and grave stones are broken, leaning or in need of repair. The families involved shall repair the stones and foundations on their own graves.

All burials including cremains must be in a vault, which will be constructed of concrete. *B.T. Can be fiberglass, plastic or other non-biodegradable materials*

No more than two cremations are permitted on a regular grave single lot. One cremation can be interred on top of an existing vault if depth permits. All burial sites must have a permanent marker. No cremains will be removed to accommodate a vault burial.

This Resolution 12-13-2016 containing Town of Maxville Cemetery Authority rules replacing Resolution 07-14-09 was adopted at the Regular Monthly Meeting of the Maxville Town Board held Tuesday evening, December 13, 2016, at 7:00 PM at the Maxville Town Hall.
